# Hghlights of the Year 2018-19

# Tobacco Control

Uttar Pradesh is the most populous state of India (over 200 million people or the size of Brazil) who live in 75 districts. It has a higher incidence of tobacco use (about 34%) than the national average. This means that the state has 42.5 million tobacco users or more than the population of the 32nd largest country (Ukraine). Tobacco is cultivated, processed and produced in the state. According the India Cancer Report, the state also has the highest prevalence of throat and mouth cancer cases - about 20% of the national burden. The age of initiation of tobacco use is among the lowest in India, and chewing, bidi smoking and cigarettes (in that order) are the principal forms of tobacco use.

Tobacco Control Programme is implemented by UPVHA with the financial support of Bloom Berg Initiatives through The Union against Tuberculosis & Lung Disease, New Delhi. The objective of the project is effective implementation and enforcement of the Tobacco Control Act (COTPA), 2003 especially Section 4, 5 and 6 in 25 districts of Uttar Pradesh.

The project envisages creating smoke free public places, Tobacco Free Educational Institutions and build capacity of the policy makers, law enforcers, coalition partners, educational institutions, Panchayati Raj Institutions, NGOs and health workers on section 4, 5, 6 & 7 of COTPA.




Orientation of Stakeholder in District Rampur under Tobacco Control Programme

### Achievements under Tobacco Control Project

- In all 75 districts meetings organized on the theme with District administration ownership.
- More than 115 circulars from district administration to all govt. establishments including education, Panchyatiraj & Health department.
- Ayodhya & Rampur district administration declared all government institutions tobacco free and other 25 districts are in advance stage to declare all government offices tobacco free.
- Almost 13500 educational institutions and 2500 other government institutions were declared tobacco free through Yellow Line Campaign. (*Till date almost 16550 government offices including educational institutions*)

# Amplify Change

Abortion is one of the leading causes of maternal dealth all over the world. Abortion is also very contested issues in many places. However India is one country where abortion laws are very liberal. A large number of abortions continue to be conducted illegaly, using dangerous methods and it contrutes large proportion to the over one hundred thousand maternal death that took place every year in country.

UPVHA is implementing Amplify Change Project to strengthening SRHR movement especially access to safe abortion by creating a network of CSOs "Sanjha Prayas" in 10 Districts of the state of Uttar Pradesh funded by Ipas Development Foundation. These districts are Lucknow, Kanpur Nagar, Sitapur, Hardoi, Barabanki, Basti, Meerut, Unnao, Shrawasti and Shahjahanpur. The objectives of the project are as follows-

- To build an enabling environment for strengthening SRHR, including access to safe abortion and contraception services at the district and state levels.
- To bring SRHR, including safe abortion on the agenda of district and state-level officials using local evidence from community-based research, planning and implementing district and state level sensitization activities.
- To sensitize local media and improve engagement on SRHR issues, including safe abortion and contraception.
- To improve access to SRHR resources, information and services at the district and state levels



### Activities under Amplify Change Project

- Meeting of CSO's network in the month of May, 2018 to discuss about the objectives of Amplify Change with network partners "Sanjha Prayas" and to develop a better understanding on project activities and budget
- Project Initiation Meeting in the month of June 2018 to develop an understanding of participants on objective, activities and outcome of the project
- Four days Learning Lab Workshop was organized in Lucknow with an objective to build the capacity of partner NGO's on SRHR especially safe abortion contraceptive and activities of Amplify Change Project and to trained participants for conducting Focused Group Discussion with identified communities accessing SRHR and abortion services and In-depth Interviews with key stakeholders.



#### Field Research Activities-

- 30 Focus Group Discussions with Married Male, Married Women, Married Young Women and Unmarried Young Women conducted in 10 Districts of Uttar Pradesh by partner NGOs
- 50 Indepth Interview conducted in 10 Districts of UP with key stakeholders like ASHA, ANM, CMO, Service Provider, PRI and Media
- Documentation Report of FGDs and IDSs prepared by partner NGOs
- Each partners submitted Consent Form, Recording, Transcription and Documentation Report to UPVHA
- First draft compiled primary research report prepared by UPVHA
- Experience Sharing and Learning Meeting organized in the month of November 2018 for sharing experiences and cross learning among partners- specifically on community research and to identify key advocacy issues which have emerged during community research

## School Awareness Program

The National Tobacco Control Programme (NTCP) was launched by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Governmnet of India 2007-08. The objective was to bring about greater awareness about the harmful effects of tobacco use and about the Tobacco Control Laws. Keeping the objective, Uttar Pradesh Voluntary Health Association is running "School Awareness Programme" in 7 Districts- Agra, Aligarh, Chitrakoot, Hathras, Jhansi, Mahoba and Kasganj of Uttar Pradesh

#### **Objective of Project-**

- To aware school children's on tobacco and to ensure the school follows the guidelines of COTPA Act, 2003.
- To bring about greater awareness about the harmful effects of tobacco use and Tobacco Control Laws.
- To facilitate effective implementation of the Tobacco Control Laws.



#### **Relevant Sections under "School Awareness Programme-**

COTPA Section- 4: Prohibition of Smoking in Public Places

#### SECTION - 4

\* "No person shall smoke in any public place:

\* Provided that in a hotel having thirty rooms or a restaurant having seating capacity of thirty persons or more and in the airports, a separate provision for smoking area or space may be made"

\* Effective from: 2nd October, 2008





#### SECTION - 6 (a)

\*Section 6 (a) of Tobacco Control Act, 2003 provides;

\* Sale of tobacco products to persons under the age of 18 is prohibited.

\* The seller should ensure that the person who is buying the tobacco product is not a minor.

\* A display board to be put up at the point of sale declaring that "sale of tobacco products to minors is prohibited".

\* Prohibition on sale of tobacco products near educational institutions

#### <u>SECTION - 6 (b)</u>

- Section 6 (b) of Tobacco Control Act, 2003 provides;
- In order to restrict access of youth for tobacco products, the sale of the same is prohibited in an area within radius of 100 yards of any educational institution.
- A display board to be put up outside the educational institutions declaring the same.
- Fine of up to Rs. 200 for violators.

# **Target Intervention**

Target Intervention Project is executed by UPVHA from last 11 years in District Ambedkar Nagar. This programme is funded by U.P State Aids Control Society. The target population under this project is female sex workers and UPVHA works with 300 FSWs to save them from risk of HIV infection.

Major activities include:

- Identification of target population and registration
- Counselling
- Contact
- Testing
- STI check-ups
- Health camps
- Group discussion
- Drop in centre
- Condom and lubes distribution
- Community organisation
- Community awareness programme



### **Activities under TI Project**

- **Community Mobilization-** The team of UPVHA continuously works at community level and provide information to
- Health and HIV Checkups- Provided regular health checkups and HIV testing of selected HRG and also provide medicines and general medical check of HRG
- DIC Activities- A cultural programme was organized at project office through HRG. They also do various activities like cultutal dance, songs etc. During the programme, information given about symptoms of HIV infection
- Trainings- Two days training was organized in the month of November 2018 for build the capacity of staff on project.
- Health Camps in Slums- A health camp was organized with the support of U.P State Aids Control Society in slums of District Tanda Nagar with the objective to know about the situation of HIV in the people of slums. Large numbers of people participated in the health camp.



• Linkages with health government officials- The volunteers of Target Intervention project continuously participated in the meetings organized by district government officials.




Participation in District Health Committee meeting


